**PLEASE READ & COMPLETE:**

- GCSE English Language** – students are not permitted to undertake a level 3 programme of A levels and BTEC options unless they have a grade 4 or higher in GCSE English Language and meet the subject specific entry requirements.
- Level 3 students must complete a minimum of 20 hours a week** – e.g. Three options plus Compulsory Study Time (CST) **or** Four options
- Extended Project Qualification (EPQ) (Year 12 and Year 13):** The standard of work is A level standard. UCAS points = 28 for an A\* (worth over half an A-level) (**Lead: PCA**). **Grade 4 in English Language** and have a passion for independent study. EPQ can only be selected with 3 A levels or more (**not 2 A levels + EPQ**). One year course.
