Dear Year 11 Parents and Carers,

Re: Examinations Expectations

I am writing to you to outline important expectations that all students must follow when taking part in the public exams this term.

- Students are expected to arrive outside their exam venue wearing full Plume Academy uniform.
- Students are to report to the specified waiting area 15 minutes prior to the exam start time to permit sufficient time for them to be registered for their examination.
- Students are to write with a black pen only.
- All mobile phones and smart devices must be turned off and stored away from the exam venue together
 with watches and earpods/earphones. Alternatively, these items may be handed in to the Exam
 Invigilators for the duration of the exam.
- Students will require the following equipment for their exams: black pen (plus a spare), pencil, ruler, calculator (where permitted), protractor and a compass. This equipment must be in a see-through pencil case. Other equipment is optional, although a calculator will be required for certain exams.
- There is no food allowed in the exam. However, students can bring a clear bottle (labels removed) filled with water or very diluted squash.
- Bottles and pencil cases must not have any writing or marking on them.

Each exam venue will have Exam Invigilators, with members of the Pastoral and Senior Leadership Team on hand so that the exams run as expected. There will be a zero-tolerance policy with regards to behaviour and any negative behaviour will be dealt with appropriately.

I very much look forward to seeing all Year 11 students complete the process and hope that they have a positive experience that not only allows them to have confidence moving into the next stage of their studies, but also achieving their full potential. To facilitate this, students will need to continue to utilise the subject catch-up, revision sessions and exam warm-up sessions that will continue to be on offer throughout the remainder of this academic year.
