Re: Student Destinations 2024

Schools and colleges are required to share data about the activity of their students with the local authority. This supports the duty of the local authority to track all young people from 16-19 years and helps identify and offer support to those young people that are not in education, employment or training (NEET).

In the vast majority of cases, Plume Academy students successfully progress into Education, Employment, Apprenticeships or Training opportunities at Post-16 and Post-18, and staff will be on hand on results days to support any students who may need additional advice and guidance.

In order to collect the required data, students are requested to complete the relevant survey for their year group on or before the A Level or GCSE Results Day (please see the relevant links below). Year 11 and Year 13 students have been fully briefed about this expectation from relevant staff prior to their departure from the academy in June 2024.
